I adilles III adilliosulput, peegusal al NEW DELHI: Prime Minister Narendra Modi is set to launch the Bharatiya Janata Party's (BJP) campaign for the upcoming Bihar Assembly elections on October 24 with two massive rallies in Samastipur and Begusarai, marking the formal start of the National Democratic Alliance's (NIDA) high-stakes battle to retain power in the state. According to party officials, Modi will begin his day in Samastipur, where he is expected to pay homage to the late socialist icon Karpoor Thakur at his native village, Karpoori Cram, before addressing a large public gathering. The choice of venue carries strong symbolic weight, as Karpoori Thakur thakur remains anduring figure among Bihar's Extremely Backward Classes (EBCS), a crucial voter base that the BJP is seeking to consolidate in this election. Court Sentences Man to 20 Years in POCSO Case **Involving Minor Girl**

The convict, Mohd

Arshad alias Nika, son of Mohd Iqbal, resident of Bain (presently at Motor Shed Chenani, Bam (presently at Motor Shed Chenani, Udhampur), was found guilty under Section 5(m) of the POCSO Act, punishable under Section 6 of the Act. The Court also imposed a fine of 750,000, directing that the amount, if realised, be handed over to the victim to meet her medical and rehabilitation expenses.
