various districts related to educational assistance, marriage assistance, death compensation, and accident compensation be



settled at the earliest.
"The last date for submitting application forms for educational assistance needs to be deferred for at least ten days beyond the already fixed dated of 20.10.2025 in view of the three holidays" he demanded

Abdul Rashid Pandit, President of the Kashmir Constructional Workers' Union, said that the amendments carried in the bylaws of the union, as mandated by the constitution of the constitution of the Building and Other Construction Welfare Workers Board, have been pending approval in the office of the Labour Commissioner for more than three years, which needs to be approved in the interest of the labourers.
