In the memorandum, Dr. Sanjay Bansal outlined key concerns impacting the ease of doing business, including discontinuation of the New Central Sector Scheme (NCSS), delays in GST refunds and incentive disbursements, lack of support for existing industries, limited access to finance due to poor NBFC presence, and unresolved industrial land issues. He emphasized that "incentives delayed are as



good as incentives denied," urging timely reimbursements with automatic interest

compensation.
Dr. Sanjay Bansal also proposed structural reforms such as a dedicated traders' reforms such as a dedicated traders' registration portal, fastregistration portar, tast-track loans for small businesses with interest subsidy, weekly virtual grievance redressal mechanisms, NTWB representation in key committees. representation
