Mankote. On this Mankote. On this occasion, Ch. Imran Zaffar, DDC Member Mankote, along with former BDC Chairperson Ch. Amanullah, held an in-depth discussion with the visiting officer and apprised him of the harsh ground realities faced by the people of this border block.

During the interaction, the public representatives highlighted that Aspirational Mankote is a sensitive border area and continues to suffer due to its geographical location and prolonged neglect. They informed that frequent cross-border shelling remains a serious concern, often resulting in injuries to civilians. In such often resulting to civilians. In such emergency situations, the absence of a properly equipped hospital for the local population.
They strongly
emphasized that the establishment of a full-fledged hospital in the block is no longer a demand but an urgent necessity to save precious

continuous shelling, fear, needs imme and lack of basic facilities, intervention from and lack of basic facilities, overall development in the block has remained severely affected. He added that despite being declared an Aspirational Block, Mankote still lacks many essential services that are fundamental for human dignity and safety. The representatives furthen highlighted that Mankote lies along a long and highly sensitive border stretch, which makes strengthening of education infrastructure extremely important. extremely important.
They stressed that quality education facilities are crucial not only for the future of children but also to prevent youth from falling into despair and migration. However, schools in the area are facing shortages of staff, infrastructure, and learning resources, which



the concerned departments Another major issue raised during the discussion was the poor condition of road condition of infrastructure infrastructure and connectivity. Ch. Amanullah pointed out that many villages remain poorly connected, making access to healthcare, education, and markets extremely difficult. In times of emergencies, bad roads touch or construction of the control of the contro emergencies, bad roads further worsen the situation and delay medical assistance. They urged the administration to prioritize road upgradation and connectivity projects in the block. The

public appealed The public representatives appealed to IRS Vivek Gupta Ji to take serious note of these issues and ensure that the

genuine concerns of the border population are border population conveyed to authorities for bound redressal. They expressed hope that the visit would translate into visit would translate into concrete action on the ground and that Aspirational Block Mankote would finally receive the attention it deserves.

The visiting officer patiently listened to the concerns raised and assured that the issues highlighted would be
