Supply Schemes in Block Bhalwal GY CORRESPONDENT JAMMU, NOV 20

In a major step towards ensur In a major step towards ensur-ing sustainable drinking water supply in rural areas, Bharat Bhushan Bodhi, District Development Council (DDC) Chairman, today visited seven ongoing water supply schemes in Block Bhalwal. These schemes, worth Rs 60 crore, are part of the Central government's initiative to provide clean and reliable drink-ing water to every household in the region under the "Har Ghar Nal Se Jal" mission.
