KISHTWAR, NOV. 20 In a significant breakthrough, Kishtwar Police have solved a burglary case within 24 hours involv-ing the theft of 60 meters of 70 Sqmm (4-core) cop-per cable worth 71.98 lakh from the Power House Complex of Pakal Dul Hydro Electric Project (HEP). The theft occurred on the night of November 18, 2024.Upon receiving a formal com-plaint from the Officer P&A of Pakal Dul HEP, a case was prombut registered at Police Station plaint from the Officer P&A of Pakal Dul HEP, a case was promptly registered at Police Station Kishtwar under FIR No. 275/2024. HANDWARA, NOV. 20 Continuing its relentless action against drug peddlers, Police in Handwara have attached a vehi-cle purchased using proceeds from alleged drug trafficking.A Tavera vehicle bearing registration number JK01V-3388 valued at 78.90 Lakhs, belong-ing to a drug peddler identified as Javed Ahmad Mir son of All Mohammad Mir resident of Dardsun. Kralpora, Kupwara, has been confiscated under Section 68(f)(1) of the NDPS Act, 1985. This action is linked to case FIR No. 173/2024 registered under sections 8/21-29 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Handwara. Investigations revealed that the vehicle was illegally acquired using proceeds from illicit trafficking in narcotic drugs and psychotropic sub-stances.
