52,000 to the fraudster account in multiple transactions. When the complainant learnt that he had
been defrauded, he rushed to Cyber Cell Kathua
and registered a complaint. During the investigation, the Cyber Cell Kathua team acted swiftly and
exhibited hectic efforts and freezed the multiple
fraudster accounts involved in the fraud. Today on
20/11/2024, the total defrauded amount of Rs
52,000 has been recovered from 03 fraudster
accounts and credited back to the account of victim
on the implementation of Court Order while further investigation in the case is in
progress. Perlinently, from the date of establinent, Cyber Cell Kathua has successfully recovered defrauded amount of Rs 557,9857- so far.
