## Police worked out theft case; arrested 3 accused recovered stolen property worth Rs 4.5 Lakhs

Police has worked out a theft case registered at Police Station Bari Brahmana district Samba by arresting three accused and recovering stolen property worth rupees 4.5 lakhs approximately from their possession. On 29-10-2024, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Bari Brahmana regarding theft of KIE wire in the intervening night of 28/29-10-2024 from a godown falling under jurisdiction of Police Station Bari

Brahmana. Upon receiving the complaint, a case FIR No. 147/2024 U/S 331(4)/305 BNS was registered at Police Station Bari Brahmana and investigation started. During the course of investigation, special team headed by SHO PS Bari Brahmana was constituted by ASP SDPO Bari Brahmana to work out the said theft case at the earliest. Police team after relentless efforts and meticulous investigation utilizing CCTV footage and other technical aids, successfully apprehended three accused namely

Gafoor Mohd S/o Kasmat Ali R/o Pacholi Deon Purmandal, Sahil Hussain S/o Mohd Din R/o Aral tehsil Mandi district Poonch A/P Tell Basti Bari Brahmana and Naushad S/o Mehaab Ali R/o Batoada Budhana Muzaffar Nagar (UP) A/P Tell Basti Bari Brahmana who upon sustained questioning confessed their involvement in the instant case. Further on the disclosure of said accused, stolen items were recovered. Investigation of the case is still going on.

Indian Army extended healthcare services to the remote parts of Rajouri district by mobile medical patrol in the village of Kalsiyar, Lam to address medical problems of the local residents as well as Gujjar and Bakkarwals in the area. The inhabitants of the area are often cut off from mainstream healthcare facilities due to their isolated geographic location and challenging terrain, benefitted immensely from this initiative which contributed to the overall well-being of the local residents who often suffer due

to disparities in healthcare leading to higher morbidity and mortality rates. The mobile medical patrol, equipped with essential medical supplies and services, reached these areas to provide healthcare with compassion for local villagers as well as Gujjar and Bakkarwals. The primary objective was to provide on-site medical care & check-ups, which included basic health check-ups, treatment of common ailments and distribution of necessary medicines. The team emphasised on preventive healthcare by offering immunizations and disseminating information about hygiene, nutri-

tion and disease prevention. The response from the local population has been overwhelmingly positive. The local population expressed deep gratitude for the Indian Army & civil administration's initiative, which brings much-needed medical services directly to their doorsteps with special focus on women healthcare. Beyond the immediate medical benefits, the mobile medical patrol played a crucial role in building and strengthening the relationship between the Indian Army and the local communities. A total of 79 villagers (21 Male, 32 Female & 26 children) were benefitted by the mobile medical patrol.

## Three drug peddlers arrested in Srinagar; contraband substances, cash recovered

J&K Police arrested three drug peddlers in Soura and Rajbagh areas of Srinagar on Wednesday and recovered contraband substances and cash from their possession. A Police party at a checkpoint established by Soura Police on 90 Feet Road near Treats, intercepted a vehicle (TATA NITER) bearing registration number PB53AM-7939 driven by Surinder Pal Saini son of Joginder Pal Saini resident of Chele Chak, District Gurdaspur, Tehsil Pathankot, Punjab. During search, 4.92 grams of Heroin and cash amount of ₹ 4,930 (believed to be proceeds of narcotics) were recovered from his possession. Preliminary investigation reveals that the accused is a chronic drug peddler who has been actively involved in selling drugs among the youth of district Srinagar. In another incident, a Police party of PS



Rajbagh during patrolling, intercepted a vehicle (Scorpio) bearing registration number JK01AV-8300 with two persons on board. They have been identified as Riyaz Ahmad Chana son of Late Ab Aziz resident of Haba Kadal and Hamza Khan son of Asif Akhan resident of Rawalpura. During search, 4 grams of Brown Sugar and a digital Kanda was recovered from their possession. They have been arrested and the vehicle used in the commission

of crime has also been seized. Regarding the incidents, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered at respective police stations and investigation has been initiated. General public is requested to report any drug-related activity or other crimes to the nearest police station or dial 112. Cooperation from the community is crucial in the fight against drugs and Police remain committed to taking strong legal action against offenders.

## Police arrested notorious thief recovers stolen motorcycle SAMBA, NOV 20

Police has arrested a notorious thief in a theft case registered at Police Station Samba and recovered stolen motorcycle from his possession. On 12-11-2024, a written report was lodged at Police Station Samba by one Sunil Kumar S/o Bhajan Kumar R/o Nardwal Samba regarding theft of his motorcycle bearing registration No. JK211-2759 from District Hospital Samba. Acting over the complaint, a case FIR No. 296/2024 U/S 303(2) BNS was registered at PS Samba and investigation started. During the course of investigation, Police arrested accused person namely Amarjeet Singh @Kaka S/o Buta Ram R/o Ucha Dhakala Berhampur, district Gurdaspur (Punjab) who upon sustained questioning confessed his involvement in the instant case. On his disclosure, stolen bike has been recovered from his possession. Further on thorough interrogation, the accused turned out to be a notorious thief cum Narco smuggler involved in different FIRs registered against him in Police Stations of State Punjab which includes:- 1. FIR No. 116/2021 U/S 379/411 IPC of PS Gurdaspur 2. FIR No. 39/2022 U/S 379/411 IPC & 21(B)/61 NDPS Act of PS Dinanagar. 3. FIR No. 32/2022 U/S 379/411 of PS Dorangla 4. FIR No. 185/2022 U/S 22/61/85 NDPS Act of PS Gurdaspur 5. FIR No. 132/2023 U/S 21/29/6/85 NDPS Act of PS Dinanagar. Further investigation of the case is going on.

## District Cyber cell Kathua recovered online defrauded amount of Rs 52000

District Cyber Cell Kathua under overall supervision of SSP Kathua Sh Shobhit Sakseena -IPS has demonstrated its commitment to combat cyber crime by recovering defrauded amount of ₹ 52,000/- Brief facts of the case are that on 10/07/2024, an offline complaint was lodged in Cyber Cell Kathua in which a complainant namely Nek Singh S/o Joginder Singh R/o Mukundpur, tehsil Merhean, Kathua reported that unknown fraudsters impersonating themselves as Police Officers called him and stated that his son has been apprehended by police for a rape and murder case. The complainant then tried to contact his son but he couldn't due to some technical glitch. Unknown fraudsters then demanded money from the complainant and he transferred the amount of ₹ 52,000 to the fraudster account in multiple transactions. When the complainant learnt that he had been defrauded, he rushed to Cyber Cell Kathua and registered a complaint. During the investigation, the Cyber Cell Kathua team acted swiftly and exhibited hectic efforts and froze the multiple fraudster accounts involved in the fraud. Today on 20/11/2024, the total defrauded amount of ₹ 52,000 has been recovered from 03 fraudster accounts and credited back to the account of victim on the implementation of Court Order while further investigation in the case is in progress. Pertinently, from the date of establishment, Cyber Cell Kathua has successfully recovered defrauded amount of ₹ 35,57,895/- so far. This achievement of District Police Kathua underscores the unit's expertise, dedication and tireless efforts in safeguarding the common citizens against online fraud and cheating. ## Police arrests 02 drug peddlers in Awantipora; Contraband substances recovered

Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from society, Police in Awantipora have arrested two drug peddlers and recovered contraband substances from their possession. A Police party of Police Station Awantipora headed by SHO Police Station Awantipora at a checkpoint established at Kaigam Crossing intercepted a vehicle (Load Carrier) bearing registration number JK13B-9030 with two persons on board. They have been identified as Amir Yousuf Reshi son of Mohd Yousuf Reshi resident of Waghama Bijbehara and Rof Ahmad Lone son of Mohd Yousuf Lone resident of Bijbehara. During search, 6 Kgs of grinded cannabis was recovered from their possession. They have been arrested and shifted to police station where they remain in custody. Vehicle used in the commission of crime has also been seized. Accordingly, a case vide FIR No.162/2024 under relevant sections of law has been registered in Police Station Awantipora and further investigation has been initiated.

## Bovine smuggling bid foiled, 20 bovines rescued, 01 vehicle seized by JKP in Subdivision Nagrota JAMMU, NOV 20

Jammu police tightening its nose against bovine smugglers under operation Kamdhenu Police team of Police Station Nagrota has foiled one bovine smuggling attempt in which 20 bovines were rescued from a vehicle Truck bearing registration number JK02CS/8087 at ban toll plaza driver namely Salman S/o Altaf R/o saharanpur UP A/P Bathandi District Jammu along with his associates namely (1) Mohd Ashraf S/o Talib Hussain R/o Talwara District Reasi (2) Mohd Shakoore S/o Mohd Gafoor R/o Miran Sahib District Jammu 20 bovines were rescued and vehicle seized. In this regard, a case FIR No. (1) 307/2024 U/S 233/BNS, 11 PCA Act has been registered in Police Station Nagrota. Further investigation is underway. General public have appreciated the continuous and strict actions of police against Bovine smugglers.
