## MVD Poonch Intensifies Action Against Traffic Violators; Rs1,31,600 Collected in Fines, 03 DLs Suspended Under ARTO Team Led by Inspector Imran Choudhary

The Motor Vehicles Department (MVD) Poonch conducted a major enforcement drive across Mandi, Chandak, Kalai, Dalera, Bainch, and Chakroo under the leadership of Inspector Imran Choudhary, (MVD) who spearheaded the campaign to curb growing traffic violations. The team carried out rigorous checking of vehicles, documents, and compliance with safety norms throughout the day. During the drive, 23 challans were issued for various offences including overspeeding, overloading, driving without mandatory documents, and non-compliance with safety guidelines. ## District police reasi nabs absconder wanted since 2012

In a major breakthrough, District Police Reasi today arrested a long-absconding accused who had been evading law enforcement for more than a decade. An absconder, Shabir Ahmad S/O Fareed Ahmad R/O Kutta Morh, Kathua; A/P Bhatindi, declared absconder under Section 299 CrPc (now Section 335 BNSS) in case FIR No. 55/2012 of Police Station Pooni, was apprehended by a dedicated team of P/S Pooni. The accused was wanted in a serious criminal case registered under sections 302, 307, 458, 366, 382, 147, 148, 323, 376, 120-B RPC. A warrant of arrest had been issued against him by the Hon'ble Court of CJM Reasi on 19-10-2012, after the challan of the case was produced in his absence. The accused had deliberately avoided arrest for years to escape the legal process. Acting on specific inputs and after sustained efforts, the P/S Pooni team successfully traced and apprehended the absconder. He will now be produced before the Hon'ble Court for further legal proceedings. The whole operation was conducted by the team of Police Station Pooni, led by SDPO Kathra Dr. Bishm Dubey, J&K, and SP Kathra Vipin Chandran, J&KSSP. ## Approx. 10 grams of heroine (chitta) like narcotics recovered by P/S Kathua; 01 drug peddler arrested.

## Samba police booked notorious inter-state drug smuggler under PITNDPS Act

Taking stringent action against notorious drug peddlers/ smugglers involved in illicit narcotics trade, Samba Police has booked a notorious inter-state drug smuggler under Prevention of Illicit Traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (PITNDPS) Act for his continuous involvement in spreading drug menace in the area and lodged him in the Central Jail Kothbhalwal Jammu. The notorious drug smuggler detained under PITNDPS Act has been identified as Abdul Habib @ Bheem S/o Maon Din R/o Ladana tehsil Ramnagar district Udhampur A/P Badheri Nanak Nakh tehsil & district Samba. The said drug smuggler has involved in different cases registered against him under NDPS Act at Police Station Samba and Police Station Nurpur (Himachal Pradesh) for his role in spreading the evil of drug addiction in the society especially amongst the youth of the



area. In view of repeated indulgence of notorious drug smuggler Abdul Habib @ Bheem in illicit drug trafficking in the area, District Police Samba prepared and submitted a dossier & other connected documents to the office of Divisional Commissioner Jammu. Accordingly, notorious drug smuggler Abdul Habib @ Bheem has been lodged in the Central Jail Kothbhalwal Jammu after obtaining formal detention order from Divisional Commissioner Jammu. It is pertinent to mention here that the said notorious inter-state drug smuggler was earlier detained under PITNDPS Act in the year 2024 and was released by Jail authority in March, 2025 after the completion of one year detention period. After being released, the accused repeatedly and continuously involved in drug trafficking which leads to registration of fresh FIRs against him under NDPS Act.

## Poonch Police Seizes 02 Dumpers & 02 Tractor Trolleys Involved in Illegal Mining

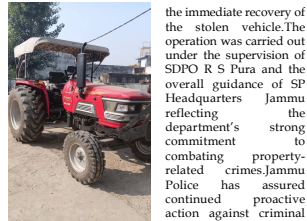


illegal mining and ensuring the protection of natural resources. The public is once again urged to refrain from engaging in any form of illegal mining and to report such activities to their nearest Police Station.
