GY CORRESPONDENT POONCH, JAN 21 A soldier was injured after stepping on a landmine in the Krishna Ghati area of Poonch district on Tuesday.Reliable sources Tuesday.Reliable sources told that the incident occurred while the soldier was part of a patrolling party and accidentally stepped on the landmine.They said the soldier, whose identity has not been disclosed, was immediately evacuated to a nearby medical facility for treatment.
