Security
of Home Affairs in North Block, Delhi.
This was the first security review meeting chaired by Home Minister Amit Shah after the assembly elections and formation of Omar Abdullah-led popular government. Earlier, similar meeting was chaired by Amit Shah in June this year. The meeting also came in the backdrop of sporadic terror attacks in Jammu and Kashmir over the past few months. In October this year seven people, including a doctor were killed in a terror attack on a construction site in central Kashmir's Ganderbal district. Prior to that, there have been several terror incidents in which outside labourers were targeted.

The meeting, sources said, took note of these incidents and measures to be taken on how to stop such incidents in the future.

Ahead of the meeting, Jammu and Kashmir chief minister Omar Abdullah also met Amit Shah to dis-

cuss several issues, including restoration of state-hood and security situation in the Union Territory. Speaking with reporters after meeting Amit Shah, Omar Abdullah said that the meeting was regarding the situation in Jammu and Kashmir, restoration of statehood. "The meeting took place in a cordial atmosphere. The experience and the hurdles that we faced in the past two months after taking over the reins following the formation of the popular government also came up for discussion during the meet,

On being asked about notifying Business Rules for Jammu and Kashmir, Omar Abdullah said that the government of India has nothing to do with it and that these are to be decided by the elected government and the cabinet. "Cabinet sub-committee will finalise the business rules, cabinet will approve it and then it will be sent to the Lt Governor. Government of India has nothing to do with it," he emarked

He also said that for now the responsibility of security, and law and order lies with the Lt Governor and he only apprised the home minister that the fight against militancy cannot be fought by creating a vac-uum. "I have always said that we cannot fight mili-tancy in a vacuum, but by taking people into confidence and for that we need to take the elected repre sentatives and the popular government in confidence." he said.

Kulgam

The operation culminated in a five-hour-long gu fight, during which five militants belonging to t Hizbul Mujahideen outfit were neutralized.

The slain terrorists were identified as Farooq Ahmad Bhat, Mushtag Ahmad Yatoo, Irfan Yagoob Adil Hajam, and Yasir Javed—all residents of Kulgam district. Farooq Ahmad Bhat, the oldest among them, had been active since 2015 and was a key commander of Hizbul Mujahideen. He had 37 FIRs registered against him. Mushtaq Ahmad Yatoo had joined the Hizbul Mujahideen cadre in 2020 and according to police, was also deeply entrenched in terrorist operations.

Brigadier Anirudh Chauhan, Commander of 2 Sector Rashtriya Rifles, while addressing the press after the gun-battle, lauded the coordinated efforts of the security forces. "We achieved significant success when we received news last night that a group of Hizbul Mujahideen cadres was present in the resi-dential area. The operation was planned meticulous-ly and launched jointly by the Army, Jammu and Kashmir Police, and CRPF. Farooq Ahmad Bhat, who played a pivotal role in reviving terrorism in the region, was among those neutralized. With the elimination of these five terrorists, not only has Hizbul Mujahideen's presence in Shopian and Kulgam been wiped out, but terrorism in Kashmir has suffered a significant setback," he told reporters.

He further credited the success to the cooperation

of local residents. "I would like to thank the people of Kulgam, who provided crucial information and extended their full support during the operation. The synergy of security forces and the commitment of the Indian Army to establish peace in Kashmir could be gauged by today's success," Brigadier Chauhan

During the encounter, two soldiers sustained gunshot injuries and were promptly evacuated to the 92 Base Hospital in Srinagar. Both are reported to be in stable condition and are expected to recover soon.

According to Javed Iqbal Matoo, DIG South Kashmir, the operation also led to the recovery of arms, ammunition, and important documents "These items will be examined as part of the ongoing investigation and have been included in the FIR. The sustained surveillance and intelligence-sharing

sustained surveillance and intentigence shalling among security agencies proved effective in today's gun-battle," Matoo said during a press briefing.

By the security grid, elimination of these key figures is being halled as a significant victory. "The killing of Faroog Ahmad Bhat and his associates has dealt a severe blow to Hizbul Mujahideen's capabili-ties in south Kashmir," Matoo said. He reiterated the security forces' resolve to root out terrorism from the

He further informed the audience that similar provision has been incorporated U/S 124 (1) & (2) of Bhartlya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) 2023.

Advocate Verma also highlighted the broader social and emotional impact of acid attacks emphasis-ing that these heinous crimes are not just physical assaults but are attacks on a person's dignity and identity. He pointed out the significant role of laws like Section 357C of the CrPC, which mandates free medical treatment for victims and the Victim Compensation Scheme, which ensures financial relief. He urged the law students to become advocates of change and spread awareness to prevent

such crimes in the future.

presented the chargesheet against Advocate Mian Abdul Qayoom, former president of the High Court Bar Association (HCBA), Kashmir, before the Special NIA Judge, Jammu, in the high-profile Babar Qadri murder case.Babar Qadri was killed by terrorists on 24 September 2020, at his residence, Zahidpora (Hawal), Srinagar.During the initial investigation, six people, including an active terrorist, were found involved in the killing and were chargesheeted

before the Special NIA Court in Srinagar in 2021.
However, in July 2023, the case was transferred for further investigation to SIA, J&K.During this, the family members of the deceased were increasingly getting suspicious after they were being threatened and pressurised against following up the case in court. The SIA, in its investigation based on oral, documentary and technical evidence, found the direct involvement of Mian Qayoom behind the killing. Mian Qayoom, who has been a separatist, was the right-hand man of the late Syed Ali Shah Geelani since the early 1990s. He reportedly had inimical relations with the deceased as the latter had challenged this one-upmanship at the Kashmiri Bar. Reports say the murdered advocate also used to speak against Oayoom for using HCBA Kashmir as a platform to further his secessionist agenda.

The deceased, Babar Qadri, had also set up a par allel body within the HCBA, named the Kashmir Lawyers Club. He was also contemplating fighting elections against Mian Abdul Qayoom, which too had not gone down well with him, sources said. Mian nad not gone down well with nim, sources sald wilan Cayoom had also reportedly extended threats to the deceased through his coterie at the HCBASources said that Mian Cayoom had earned notoriety in the last two decades for literally treating the HCBA Kashmir as his fieldom and converting it into a conkashmir as in selection and converting trains a con-stituent of the All Party Hurriyat Conference (APHC). He had been issuing hartal calendars in the Kashmir valley on behalf of HCBA Kashmir, concurrently with strike calls given by the late Syed Ali Shah Geelani-led APHC.

Mian Oayoom had been so emboldened by the support he received at the hands of separatists that he had once declared in open court that he did not believe in the Constitution of India. Ironically, he had established a highly lucrative legal practice in the same High Court which was established under the provision of the very Indian Constitution he refused to accept. The in-depth investigation conducted by to accept. The in-depth investigation conducted by the SIA revealed that Mian Cayoom entered into a criminal conspiracy with the terrorists of the banned TRF outfit. The TRF is a proxy organisation for Lashkare-Foliab (LeT), formed after the reorganisation of the erstwhile J&K State on 5 August 2019, and their handlers in Pakistan.

The terrorists, on 24 September 2020, entered the house of the deceased and fired bullets at him, leading to his death while being shifted to Sher-i-Kashmir Institute of Medical Sciences, Soura, Srinagar, the chargesheet said.It is interesting to note that Babar Qadri had developed some kind of premonition on the day of his killing so much so that he went live on Facebook a few hours before the incident and expressed his fears of being eliminated.Tragically, that same evening, he was killed by the waiting terrorists who entered his house in the guise of clients and met him on the pretext of discussing some case.

Mian Qayoom was arrested on 25 June 2024, and has since been lodged in District Iail. Jammu Though the initial trial in this case was going on in Srinagar, the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir in December 2023, transferred the trial to Jammu, taking note of 2023, fransierred the irlai to Jammu, taking note in the judicial process and the threat to the victim's family at the hands of Mian Qayoom. The police on Thursday presented a detailla 340-page-long supplementary chargesheet before the Special Judge under the NIA Act, Jammu, against Mian Qayoom. The trial in the case against Mian Qayoom is expected to begin soon.
