Blind murder case solved, missing turned into murder accused arrested: reasi Police

On 9 December 2023 an information was received at Police Station Chassana that one dead body of deceased namely Mohd Rafiq S/O Mahamud R/O Jia Baggo Dass was found in suspicious circumstances at Village Jia Baggo Dass. On this information, an inquest proceeding under Section 174 Cr.PC vide DDR No. 04 was initiated at P/S Chassana and inquiry taken up.

During the course of inquiry it was observed that the deceased had been killed by some unknown persons on which the instant inquest was converted and accordingly a formal case FIR No. 08/2024 U/S 302, 120 B IPC was registered at Police Station Chassana and investigation was taken up by *Insp. Ranjeet Singh Rao SHO P/S Chassana under the close supervision of Ajaz Choudhary SDPO Mahore and overall Supervision of MS Mohlta Sharma-IPS SSP Reasi.

During the course of investigation some suspects were rounded up and after strenuous efforts and with the help of technical assistance it came into fore that during the intervening night of 8/9 December 2023 four persons namely

Nazir Ahmed S/O Ruslila
Shahir Ahmed S/O Mohd Abdullah
Nazir Ahmed S/O Abdullah and
Farooq Ahmed S/O Bashir Ahmed all residents of Jia Baggo Dass met together at the house of one Nazir Ahmed S/O Ruslila and hatched a criminal conspiracy against the deceased and assaulted the deceased with a stick on his head resulting which the deceased died on the spot. Thereafter all the accused persons took the dead body and dumped it about 500 metre away in a road from the place of crime. As investigation progressed, all the four accused were arrested and on their disclosure the weapon of offence was also recovered. Locals have hailed the efforts and professionalism of police in solving this blind Murder.

SSP Reasi expressed that such barbaric acts done by criminals is rarest of the rare and such criminals are a black spot on our social fabric. She further stressed that investigation shall incorporate each and every evidence to ensure justice is ensured in this heinous act.

Drug awareness cum surprise checking of selective Kullas by JKP in the Pouni Chak area of District Jammu

Jammu and Kashmir Police Registers 03 FIRs arrests 03 Bovine Smugglers Seized 02 Vehicles, Rescues 41 Bovines

Jammu and Kashmir Police Continuing its drive against the bovine smugglers and their propagators under Operation KAMDHENU. Ramban police under the supervision of SSP Ramban Sh.Anuj Kumar-IPS has foiled bovine smuggling attempts, registered 03 FIRs arrested 03 bovine smugglers, rescued 41 bovines and seized 02 vehicles. Police team of Police station Batote headed by SHO Batote during Patrolling duties intercepted a person namely Bashir Ahmed son of, Abdul Rashid resident of Khadnyar Baramulla who was taking 11 bovine animals on foot towards Kashmir without any valid permission. In another instance Police Party of PS Chanderkote headed by SHO Chanderkote foiled Bovine smuggling bid intercepted a vehicle bearing registration No JK 21H 3068 and held one person namely Ashiq Ali son of Shaffi Mohd resident of Gool Ramban. During checking 4 bovines were found laden inside the vehicle which were tied in a cruel manner and were being transported illegally towards Kashmir. In another instance Police Party of PS Banihal headed by SHO Banihal foiled a bovine smuggling bid, intercepted a vehicle bearing registration No JK19 A 5234 and held one person namely Asif son of Mohd Arif resident of Ramban. During checking, 26 bovines were found laden inside both the vehicles, which were tied in a cruel manner and were being transported illegally towards Kashmir. As a result, a total of 41 bovine animals were rescued under the operation "KAMDHENU". Subsequently, FIR Nos. 61/2024 was registered at Police Station Batote. FIR No 60/2024 at PS Chanderkote and FIR No 64/2024 at PS Banihal under Sections 188 IPC and under section 11 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act. The investigation has been initiated into these cases. 02 persons arrested and 02 vehicles involved in the commission of offence have been seized. The successful rescue operation was conducted by Police parties led by SHO Police Station Batote, SHO PS Chanderkot and SHO PS Banihal under the supervision of DySP Hqrs Ramban, SDPO Banihal, Addl.SP Ramban, with the overall supervision by SSP Ramban.
