Channi's remark sets benchmark for India Bloc stooping to new low: Kavinder thes out at Faroog Abdullah for 'speaking in Pakistan's language' on POJK issue

Senior BJP leader and former Deputy Chief Minister, Kavinder Deputy Chief Minister, Kavinder Gupta has strongly criticized the derogatory remarks made by Congress leader and former Chief Minister of Punjab, Charanjit Singh Channi, regarding the martyrdom of an IAF warrior in the Surankote terrorist attack in Poonch district. He called for an apology from the India Bloc for disrespecting the valor of our brave soldiers.

In a statement issued here today, Kavinder said, "India Bloc leaders have stooped so low that

for them. Pakistan and foreign interests take precedence over our interests take precedence over our national security. They exhibit a concerning pattern of questioning the integrity and sacrifices of our armed forces, even in the face of clear evidence."

He emphasized, "During the Pulwama attack, when Pakistan openly admitted its involvement, Congress leaders shamelessly raised doubts. Channi's recent remarks are yet another example of their disregard for the sacrifices made by our brave soldiers.

An inspection drive led by Assistant Drug Controller Anantnag regarding the imple-mentation of CCTV surveillance mentation of CCTV surveillance and computerized billing systems in medical establishments within tehsil Bijbehara led to suspension of two Pharmaceutical distribu-tors. During the inspection, a team of Drug Control Officers conducted thorough inspections of around 20 medical establishments in and around SDH Bijbehara. The focus of these inspections was to verify compliance with directives regardinspection were largely positive, with nearly all chemists having installed CCTV cameras and installed CCTV cameras and adopted computerized billing sys-tems within their establishments. However, the operation of two wholesale firms, M/s Janisaar Enterprises Pharmaceutical Enterprises Pharmaceutical Distributors Bijbehara and M/s New Iqbal Enterprises Pharmaceutical Distributors Bijbehara, was temporarily sus-pended due to non-compliance with the computerized billing sys-tem and other unidentified viola-

Following the inspections, stringent directives were issued to all medical establishments in the medical establishments in the region. They were instructed to strictly adhere to guidelines regarding the implementation of computerized billing system (CBS) and issuance of computerized cash memos. Additionally, retailers were advised to only accept invoices generated through a computer-ized billing system from their dis-tributors and suppliers.
