"Tomorrow, 6 June, is indeed a special day for my sisters and brothers of Jammu and Kashmir. Key infrastructure projects worth Rs. 46,000 crores are being inaugurated, which

will have a very positive impact on people's lives." Terming railway bridges on the USBRI. link as "extraordinary feat of architecture," PM Modi further wrote: "The Chenab Rail Bridge will improve connectivity between Jammu and Srinagar.
