Holding so, the Court refused to entertain a challenge to a recruitment notification issued by the

The bench of CJI BR Gavai and Justices K Vinod Chandran and NV Anjaria was hearing a writ petition challenging the recruitment cotification issued on May 14 for the post of Civil Judge (Junior Division) in Subordinate Judiciary rolled out by Jammu & Kashmir Public Service Commission, Live Law reported. On May 20, the Supreme Court delivered its judgment mandating 3 years of legal practice before applying for judicial exams. The petitioners, who are practising advocates in the trial courts of J&K, challenged the province of the provinc
