GY CORRESPONDENT JAMMU, JULY 28 In our scriptures, lunar dates (tithis) are considered highly significant. The deities associated with specific tithis are best worshipped on those days for fulfilling wishes and receiving divine blessings. The presiding deity of the Panchami tithi is the Nag Devta (Serpent God). Hence, worshipping serpents on this day removes fear, diseases, and the iil effects of Kaal Sarp Dosh. Mahant Rohit Shastri, Head of Shri Kailakh jyotish avim Vedic Sanshan Trust, stated hat the feistival of Nag Panchami isclebrated on tho. Penchergi tithi of the 29 July, the Nag Panchami festival will be celebrated on Tuesday, 29 July 2025. However, there are regional variations in observing Nag Panchami. For instance, it is celebrated on Shravan Krishna Panchami in Raiasthan and Bengal, on that the restrival of Nag Panchami is celebrated on the Panchami tithi of the Shukla Paksha (waxing phase) in the month of Shravan. According to the Panchang, this year the Panchami tithi of Shravan

Krishna Panchami in Rajasthan and Bengal, on Shravan Shukla Panchami in North India, and some people in Jammu (Duggar Pradesh) observe it on Rishi Panchami of Bhadrapada Shukla. Still, the festival is most videly observed on Shravan Shukla Panchami. Panchamì tithi of Shravan Shukla Paksha begins on Monday, 28 July at 11:25 PM and ends on Tuesday, 29 July at 12:47 AM. Since the Panchami tithi prevails during sunrise on Nag Panchami teaches us that all creatures are

in on the tady of Fair respected in India, as the balance of nature depends on the coexistence of all beings. In Hinduism, serpents have been revered since ancient times. Therefore, we must protect snakes and not harm them without reason.

reason. If a household has a serpent idol, it should be worshipped; otherwise, a snake can be made from pure clay and worshipped. If there is a worshipped. If there is a snake's burrow (naag baambi) nearby, one may offer a coconut, milk, sweets (roti), flowers, garland, and donation. On this day, chanting the mantra helps in neutralizing the effects of

snake venom. On this festival, people On this festival, people purify house walls with red ochre (geru), draw square diagrams using coal and ghee paste, carve serpent figures within it, and perform the ritual worship. In some places, the serpent figures are drawn on paper or with sandalwood paste. After the worship. Brahmins the worship, Brahmins are fed, and the needy are

given clothes, food, and donations. It is forbidden to dig the und on Panchami tithi. ose suffering from ground on Panchami tithi. Those suffering from malefic Rahu-Ketu effects in their horoscope, those afraid of snakes, those desiring progeny, those desiring progeny, those who may have accidentally harmed a snake, or who frequently dream of serpents, should observe Nag Puja and fasting on this day. Additionally, release snakes from snake charmers, feed cows, and chant.
